GENERAL RULES

1. Awards are indivisible.
2. Only participants duly registered for the Congress are eligible.
3. Each participant may apply for a single award.
4. The deadline for submission of applications is 11 May 2026 (strictly).
5. All submitted documentation must fully comply with the requirements set out in this call.
6. Winners will be notified during the Congress.
7. Applications must be submitted via PEC to: magnoorganizersrls@pec.it, indicating the award applied for and attaching all required documentation.

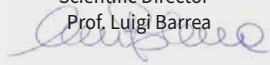
REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

1. Curriculum Vitae (European format)
 - Dated and self-certified.
 - Bibliometric data (mandatory): H-index from Scopus, total citations, total number of publications in PubMed, publications in the last five years, number of papers as first/last author.
 - Distinction between original articles and reviews/meta-analyses.
 - Any prizes or recognitions received.
2. Valid identity document
3. Review or abstract proposal
 - Must be written exclusively in English, following the attached template.
 - The award will be conferred to the first author present at the Congress; in their absence, the award will be assigned to one of the co-authors attending.

Applications will only be considered valid if the complete documentation is submitted in full compliance with this call.

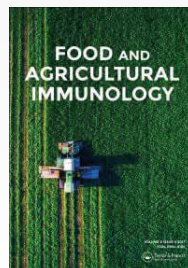
